provided she the said Ann is know to have any Commucation with
Nathan Beal this Legacy to Cease from that time-, all the re-
maing part of my Estate Real ~~and~~ personal, not already beeded
of Coveyed away I give and Bequeath to my Brother William
Townsend Kirkland Whom I ordain Constitute my True and Lawful
Executor and I do herby Disallow Disown & Disannul all other
Wills hereafefore made By me Confirming this to be my last
Will and Testament in Witnefs hereof I have set my hand and
Seal this 24th of March in Year of Lord one thousand Eigh
tand & seven and in the thirty first Year of america Inde-
pendance
