Do make & ordaine this my Last Will & Testament in manner & form following. Item I Recomend my Soul into the Hands of Almighty God, & my Body to the Earth, to be buried in a decent Christian Manner at the Discretion of my Executors hereafter named --Item I give & bequeath to my Son John M Evoritt one Negro Boy by the Name of Will, after my Wifes Widowhood, also four hundred Acres of Land lying & being, the upperside of the Horse Peen, to be porcent with at the Age of Twenty one Years to him & his Heirs for Ever-Item I give & bequeath to my Son Thoma. Everitt one Negro Boy by the name of Amon, after my Wifes Widowhood, Also my Plantation & Land whereon I now Live, after the Leath of my Nife & the Marriage of mil my Daughters, Vis ! Polly, Luckey, Mancy, Salley & Tempe to him & his Helrs for Ever--Item I give a bequeeth to my Son in Law William Dyefs, one hundred Acres of land lying betwirt Chandlers Land,& t.e upper Edge of the Little Capey Pond, & my Line near the new Road, aforesaid, Dyefs's Line, to him & his Heirs for Ever. Item I lend to my Loveing Wife Mancey Everitt, my Plantation & Land thereto belonging, indureing her Natural Lif., also I lend her all the rest of my personal Estate indureing her -Widowhood, and after her Widowhood, my Will is that all my Estate but what I have already given to my Bons, should be equally divided between my Six Daughters. Vis! Elizabeth Dyefs, Polly Everitt, Lukey Everitt, Mancy Everitt, Sally Evoritt, & Tempe Evoritt, to them & their Heirs for Everljem I constitute & make & ordanse my Son Will" Dyefs, & my loveing Wife Mancy Everitt Joint Executors of this my last Will & Testament, Revoking & disanulling all other former Wills, ratifying & confirming this my last Will &
