I George Latham of the district and State aforesaid, bring Sick and weak in body but of Sound and disposing mind memory and understanding praise, be to God for the same do make and declare this my last will and Testament, in manner and form following, that is to say, AS soon after my decease, as my be convenient and proper I authorise my Executors herein after named and appointed or the survivor of them, to sell and dispose of the whole of my estate both real and personal upon such term as they shall judge best & most advantageous and the proceed thereof after paying all my just debts, I will & bequeath unto my Nephew Gabriel Freeman Son of Thomas & Susannah Freeman of Culpepper County in the State of Virginia the residue thereof, be the same more or less, to him, his Executors administrators, & assigns: And I do hereby particularly request my Executors as aforesaid to support and protect by all legal ways & means my claim to an undivided forth part of the land which I totily obtained by a writ of partition between the late William Minor and my self which mority or half part is the same land I sold some years ago to Mefsuries Hunt & Shaw in in Philadelphia reserving by an agreement with Wm. Hunt an interest in one forth part thereof. And I also, do request, my Executors as aforesaid to invest on being paid three forths of the expences which I have laid out in prosecuting the suit against the Said Minor as will as all subsequent expences which I estimate in the whole to amount at least to five hundred dollars, and
