CHRISTOPHER HICKS

In the name of God Amen. I Christopher Hicks of the State of South Carolina & County of Winton being in a low State of Health tho' of a Perfect & sound Memory, do constitute this my last Will & Testament as followeth---Item I give & bequeath to my well beloved Son Armstead Hicks, the one hundred & fifty acres of Land whereon I now live, provided never theles that my well beloved wife Wilmoth hold possession of the same dureing her life time, & I do hereby appoint my wife Wilmoth Executrix, & my Son Armisted Executor, of this my Last Will & Testament. I give & bequeath to my Son Armistead a Waggon & Cier thereunto belonging, I Lend to my well beloved wife dureing her natural Life, one Negro Boy named George, and after her Death to be the Value thereof equally divided between my Son Armistead, & my two Daughters Sarah & Prudence, giving my said Son the priviledge to keep the foresaid Negro himself, and aying my two aforesaid Daughters their equal parts thereof. I lend to my wife Wilmoth all the Stock I am posseſed of both Horses, Cattle & Hogs, dureing her Life, whick is to equally divided at her Death, between my three Children my Son Armistead and my two Daughters Sarah & Prudence. I give & bequeath to my Son Armisted my Smiths Tools, and as to my House furniture, I Lend to my wife dureing her Life, & at her Death to be equally divided between my three Children Vix. my Son Armistead & my two Daughters Sarah & Prudence. In witness whereof I have hereunto set my Hand & Seal this Seventh Day of September, One thousand seven hundred and Ninety Eight-----
