JACOB THOMAS

In the Name of God Amen, I Jacob Thomas of the District of Barnwell and State of South Carolina being Very Sick and Weak of body but of perfect mind and memory, and knowing the Transitory State of all things desire to make my last will and Testament. That is to say first I bequeath my Soul into the hands of God that gave it and my body to be buried in a Christian like and decent manner at the Discretion of my Executors hereafter named and as touching Such Worldly Goods wherewith it hath pleased God to blefs me With I Give and dispose of in the following manner, first it is my Will and Desire that as Soon as Convenient after my Death that that the Whole of my property of all kinds and Discriptions Whatsoever to be Sold and to be Collected and put into the hands of my Son Reuben Thomas and by him at his descretion to go to the Maintenance of my beloved Wife and at her Death to be Equally divided between Reuben Thomas Jacob Thomas and South Derby to them and their heirs forEver It is further my will that the wish of my Children or their representatives receive Each of them One Dollar and no more as I have Given them before what I intended, It is also my Will and Desire that my Son Reuben Thomas be Executors of this my last Will and Testament ratifying and Confirming ~~this~~ as my last Will and Disannuling all others by me heretofore made in Witnefs Whereof I have hereunto Set my hand and Seal this 15th Day of July 1805
