JAMES DAVIS

In the Name of God Amen I James Davis of the County of Winton
in South Carolina being through the abundant Mercy of God the
weak in Body, Yet of Sound and perfect Understanding and Mem-
ory I do Constitute this to be my Last Will and Testament and
desire it may be Received by all as Such, First I most humb-
ly Bequeath my Soul to God, my Maker Beseeching his most Gra-
cious Acceptance through the all Sufficient Merits & Mediation
of my Most Compassionate Redeemer Jesus Christ Amen, blest
be the Name of God. - I give my body to the Earth from whence
it was taken in full Assurance of its Resurrection from
~~the Earth~~ at the last day. I Constitute my Wife Ann Davis as an
executrix and my Sons Gardiner & James Davis as Executors I
Bequeath my Lands and all my Living Viz. four Negroes Namely
Lucy, Hannah, Joseph, & Philia, my Horses Cattle &c to my Be-
loved Wife during her Natural life and also at the decease of
my Wife I bequeath my whole Living that is to say both Real and
personal Estate to my Three Sons Viz. Gardiner, James & Budd
Davis by an Equal distribution amongst the Three In Witness
whereof I have hereunto Set my hand and Seal this Thirteenth
day of October 1793 --
