JAMES JACKSON SENIOR

In The Name of God Amen I James Jackson Senior of the State of South Carolina and Barnwell District being weak in body but of sound and perfect mind and memory do make and ordain this my present and Last will and Testament first and principally I recommend my Soul into the hands of Almighty God and my body I Comit to the Earth to be Decently Buried at the Discretion of my Executors hereafter Named and as Touching all Such Temporal Estate as it hath pleased Almighty God to bestow upon me I Give and Bestow Thereof as follows First I would That my Funeral Charges and all my Debts Should be paid and discharged then I Give and Bequeath unto my Beloved wife Ferebea Jackson and one brown bay mare which I have raised by the name of Sprig Likewise with all my house hold Firniture Dureing her life or wide hood Likewise I Leave my Stock of Cattle for the use of my famely and the remaind of them to be Equally Dividd among my beloved Children when they all come of age my Stock of Higgs I Leave for the use of my family as before mentioned besides two head of horses and one Set of blacksmiths Tools which I Leave to be sold to pay my Debts Likewise my part of the three Hundred and Sixty two acres of Land to be Equally divided between my four Children at the Death of my beloved wife and mother Likewise My Negro Fellow Sam with my part of all the rest of the Negros which is one third to be Equally Divided Among four Children/ which is Rutha Jackson Judea Jackson Joshua Jackson Ivy Jackson at the Death of my beloved mother and wife Likewise there is two Hundred acres of Land more or less lyng and binding on the Little Saltke- toher which said land I have bargained and sold to John Backs- ley but not Rec'd any thing in payment and I do Empower my

wise my part of the three Hundred and Sixty two acres of Land  
to be Equally divided between my four Children at the Death  
of my beloved wife and mother Likewise My Negro Fellow Sam  
with my part of all the rest of the Negroes which is one third  
to be Equally Divided Among four Children/ which is Rutha Jack-  
son Judea Jackson Joshua Jackson Ivy Jackson at the Death of  
my beloved mother and wife Likewise there is two Hundred acres  
of Land more or less lying and binding on the Little Saltke-  
toher which said land I have bargained and Sold to John Backs-  
ley but not Rec'd any thing in payment and I do Empower my  
Exetors to make him good and Sufficent and Lawful Titles  
and rights for the above named Track of Land when he pays them  
one half and Givea his notes for the Remainder accorden to my  
contract and the above named John Backsley and to deliver  
the payment to my Dear beloved wife Verebia Jackson to the

Seport of her and her Famely and I Further Lend to my beloved wife Ferabia Jackson my Negro fellow Sam with all my part of the Rest of the Negroes which is one third during her life and widowhood and all the rest of my Estate real and personal Estate after the Death of my Dearly beloved mother for her to use at her Discretion for the Support of herself and family in raising and Schooling my four Children before named and what of my Estate is remaining at her Death or marriage Shall bee Equally divided among all my Children That is then Living --- and lastly I appoint Constitute and ordain my Trusty and well beloved wife Ferabia Jackson and my beloved trusty fried Stephen Green to be my Executors to this my last will and Testament ratifying and Confirming them and no others in witness whereof I have Hereunto Set my hand and Seal thi Dec 10th 1803
