In the Name of God Amen I James Moodie of the State of South Carolina Barnwell District being weak in body but of Sound & Perfect Memory do make this my Last will and Testament in Manner & form following (Viz) First I will & Bequeath to my son James Moodie the Tract of Land where I now live containing two hundred acres also one Bay horse Twenty even head of Cattle Ten head of Hogs all my house hold furniture and working tools Second I give & bequeath to my Daughter Jane Moodie one Small Barrel horse also to her three Children (Viz) Richard one cow John one cow & william one year old heifer- Third I give & Bequeath to my Daughter Charity Davis ~~five Dollars to each~~. Fourth I give & Bequeath to Nancy Rottenberry one year old heifer &c----- I do here by nominate and appoint James Moodie and Jane Moodie Executors & Executrix to this my last will and testament all other Will or Wills by me made to be void this only to Stand in full force Witnefs my hand & Seal this fourth day of December in the year of our Lord one thousand eight hundred & nine & in the Thirty fourth year of the Independance of the United States of America-----
