In the name of God amen I John Blitchendon of Barnwell District South Carolina being of Sound mind and memory but Sick and be very infirm of body do make constitute and ordain this present to be my Last will and testament first I recommend and Then commit my Soul into the hands of God that give it trusting through his mercy to receive it again with joy at the day of the Resurrection of the dead and my body to be buried in a decent christian manner at the discretion of my executors and as to such worldly goods as it hath pleased god to blefs me with I leave will and dispose of them in the following manner first that my executors Shall pay all Just and lawfull debts and funeral charges 2d I give and bequeath unto my grand Son John Hickman a tract of land containing of one hundred and Sixty nine acres more or lefs being part of a tract of land laid out to John Blitchendon henny day and thomas draper lying on the half moon Branch I give and bequeath unto my daughter Rebecka hickman my stock of Cattle and hogs and all of my mark which is a crap and alit in each ear and over bit in the left ear and it is my desire and will that the said Rebecka Hickman Shall have one bay mare and man Saddle one feather bed and furniture one bed Stead with all the other house furniture and it is also my desire and as mary day anna tyler Sarah blalock william blitchendon have all ready Received by me their portion ap parts or as much as I think to be Suffi- cient for them I do finally give and bequeath to the Said mary day anna tyler Sarah blalock william blitchendon five Shillings each and Barnwell County Tenn 1787-1798 and finally I do

cient for them I do finally give and bequeath to the Said
mary day anna tyler Sarah blalock william blitchendon five
Shillings each and to each of them and lastly and finally I do
appoint^{and} nominate my Son in law Thomas Hickman to be the only
Sole executor of this my last will and testament given under
my hand and Seal this the eighteenth day of September one
Thousand eight hundred and three and in the twenty eight year
of the independency of the united States of america
