JOHN FITTS

State of South Carolina In the name of God Amen, I John Fitts
of Barnwell District in the State aforesaid, being of sound
mind and memory, do make this my last Will and Testament in
manner and form following: (That is to say) first I desire that
I may have a decent Burial, and that my funeral expenses and
just debts be first paid. Item I give and bequeath to my loving
wife Sarah and each of my lawful children, all my property
both real and personal, to be equally divided among them, Share,
and Share alike, except my Son William Fitts, to him I desire
one Shilling to be paid out of my Estate as his share, and to
the Children of the said William Fitts, I desire that they have
one Share of my Estate, with my wife and children, to be equal-
ly divided among them Share and Share alike. And in case
either of my children should die without lawful Issue, I desire
that their Share be equally divided among the survivors. Item
I give and bequeath to my loving wife Sarah my riding chair and
barnefs, and her Choice of one of my Horses, also all m. house-
hold and Kitchen firneture during her lifetime, and after her
death to be equally divided among the children of her body, I
also give to my said wife the use of my dwelling House and Plan-
tation, during her lifetime, in Lieu of Loyer. I further de-
sire, and it is my intent and meaning, that my little negro
girl named Molly shall be valued and that my said wife may-may
if she thinks fit, take her at the valuation, but to be conside-
red as part of her share of my Estate.-It is also my desire
and will, that the chile my wife is now pregnant with, shall
have an equal share of my Estate with the rest of my children.
