The other half to F Godfrey all my household furniture Except a Mahogany fram looking Glafe I leave to F H Godfry all my farming utenteals and Kitchen furniture which shall be infull of of the Cows hogs and shoop I made over to her in her marriage settlement also all my Crop that may be growing or in the house at the Barnwell County Wills 1787-1798 time of my decease www.southcarolinapionetes.het and her heirs

The other half to F Godfrey all my household furniture Except a Mahogany fram G looking Glafe I leave to F H Godfry all my farming utenteals and Kitchen furniture which shall be infull of of the Cows hogs and shoep I made over to her in her marriage settlement also all my Crop that may be growing or in the house at the time of my decease: The above I leave to her and her heirs. for Ever; and in Case she chout die without heirs of her Body lawfully Begottong.
