In the Name of Train, I John Taylor being of Sound Mind & Monory do make this my last will & Testament revoking all others heretofore made by me - That is to say, I leave to my half Brother Elias Taylor, the son of my Mother - thi following summe of money. Vis. the sum of Seventy Dollars due me by Joseph Ashton of Augusta for one year riding past, and Forty five Dollars due me by Issac Roberts formerly of Coosahatchie, and now of Savannah in Georgia, and Twenty One Dollars due me by Jefse Loper of Beech Branch And Twenty One Dollars fifty Cents due me by Michael Swicord, emounting in the whole to One Hundred & Fifty Seven Dollars and fifty Cents, together with my Wearing apparel, and all other property Belonging to me of what nature & kind soever - lastly I nominate and appoint my friend Wm. Michael Swicord my executor -/ In testamony whereof I have hereunte set my hand & Seal this 8th day of April 1806 Signed Seal'd and delivered by the testator In the presence of us )
