JOHN TAYLOR

In the Name of ~~God~~ ~~the Father~~, I John Taylor being of Sound Mind & Memory do make this my last will & Testament revoking all others heretofore made by me - That is to say, I leave to my half Brother Elias Taylor, the son of my Mother - the following sum of money, Vis. the sum of Seventy Dollars due me by Joseph Ashton of Augusta for one year riding past, and Forty five Dollars due me by Isaac Roberts formerly of Coosahatchie, and now of Savannah in Georgia, and Twenty One Dollars due me by Jesse Loper of Beech Branch And Twenty One Dollars fifty Cents due me by Michael Swicord, amounting in the whole to One Hundred & Fifty Seven Dollars and fifty Cents, together with my Wearing apparel, and all other property Belonging to me of what nature & kind soever - lastly I nominate and appoint my friend Wm. Michael Swicord my executor - In testimony whereof I have hereunto set my hand & Seal this 8th day of April 1806 Signed Seal'd and delivered -
