JOSEPH HARLEY

In the Name of God amen I Joseph Harley of the State of South Carolina destitute of Orangebourgh and County of Winton being weak of Body but of sound and perfect Mind and Memory, Do make and publish this my last will and Testament in Manner and form following ----- First I Recommend my Soul to God through the Merits of my Saviour and Redemer and my body to be decently Interred at the discrefsion of my Executors Hereafter named --- Item I will and bequeath to my Eldest son Henry Harley his Riding horse Called Rodgers with saddle and Bridle, also all the Cattle that are Called his with their future Increase, To be at his free disposal when he Comes of age, also one Hundred acres of land where he may Chuse Except where the Improve-ments is that I now live on ----- Item I will and be-queath to my Son Joseph Harley his Riding horse Called Buck with a Saddle and Bridle, also all the Cattle that are Called his with their future Increase, also one Hundred acres of land where he may Choose after his Brother, - Except where the Im-provements is that I now live on ----- Item I give and Bequeath to my loveing wife Elizabeth Harley one third of my Goods and Chattles to Possess and Injoy the same during her life time. and at her decease to devolve to my Childering Survveing a-mongst whom to be Equally divided ----- Item It is my will that the Remainder of all my Real and personall Estate and propperty be Kept together; and Improved for the Benefit of my other Children untill they Come of age; and then that their Cattle which is Called theirs with their future Increase shall devolve to my Said Children; also I will that my said Children shall have Sufficient Schooling & Maintenance that they may be able to support themselves.

Cloathing out of my said Estate; desbursed by my Executors Item  
I will and bequeath that all my Real and personall Estate of  
Every Kind whatsoever which I stand Pofessed of (Except what I  
have willed away to my Two Sons) Shall be Equally devidid  
among all my Childeren - Childeren Share & Share alike - And  
lastly I do hereby nominate Constitute and appoint my Beloved  
wife Elizabeth Harley and my Two Sons Henry and Joseph Harley  
to be my Executors of this my last will and Testament Revoking
