my Dearly beloved Wife Elizabeth, during her Widowhood all my
Estate, both real, and Personal, reserving from It money suf-
ficient for the schooling of my Son James, as my Executors
hereafter named may Deem asufficiently agreeable to my resources
and thirdly, at the death of Wife or marriage, It is my Will,
that the Land Whereon I now reside, shall belong to my son
James, and fourthly, that the residue of my personal Est.^d
shall be equally Divided among my three childred, Mahala,
Julia, & James, and In case either should die without Issue
lawfully begotten It is my Will that It return to the others
surviving and lastly I do hereby appoint my trusty Freind
James Purse and my Son James My Lawful Executors, to this my
last will and testament to Execute In manner & form as the
Law directs. In witness whereof I have hereunto set my hand
and seal this tenth day of July 1816 and In the Forty ~~6th~~
y^s first year of American Independance.
