out of my property in a Manner to Suit my Executors

Secondly. I Bequeath to my well beloved wife Ann Chase All my
Estate Real and Personal to blong to her as her property

Thirdly I do hereby Constitute and appoint my Dear wife as Exe-
cutrix and my trusty friend Charles McClellan as Executor to
