Secondly I Lond to my Dearly beloved wire all My lands with the Buildings and Improvements thereon also all my personal property moveable ffects and household furniture during her natural life or widowhood and after her decease or widowhood I give to my Eldest Son Daniel Treadaway one hundred acres of Land on the East. lide of the upper three Runs adjoining The tract I now live on on the Northeast Side of the same being part of tract of one hundred and fifty acres originaly Granted to the Said Richard Treadaway also one hundred and four acres adjoining the aforesaid one hundred acres on the East Side of the Same being part of a tract of three hundred and Sixtytwo and half acres of later date granted to the Sold RichardBawevelly@ountwidilisa1787-1798

with the buildings and Improvements Thereon orriginally granted to William West ----- also one hundred and four acres of land adjoining the eforecaid one mindred and four scree Mentioned to Richard Red on the South side of the same in the aforesaid Later Survey which Said Legacies of Jands by the aforesaid legatees to be freely pofesed of and Injoyed with Tifthly all my personal Estate with my houshold furniture &c. to be Equeally divided by the aforesaid Paniel Treadaway and Blijah Treadaway into three Chares and they Takeing one Sharb ach and the other Share I desire to be Sold at the Same time by my Executor on a Credit of Eighteen Months and the Money when Collected to Remain in my Executors hands for him to act with as he Shall Jee most Beniffelal for the Said Richard Red untill the Said Richard Red Shall Come to the age of Twentyone years and then he shall be Intilled to Receive from the Said Executor the Sum Remaining at that time of him the Said Richard Reds Comping of age in the said Executors hand and if the said Richard Red 'Thould Not live to have A Lawfull heir of his own body Then the aforesaid Legacy of Land and Money above Mentioned to him Shall Return and be Equeally Divided between the aforesaid Daniel Treadoway and Elijan Trockery to be freely possessed of with their other Legacies and I do hereby Constitute make and ordain My Beloved wife Mary Treadaway Executrix with my Son Elijah Treadaway Executor of this my last will and Testament, and I do hereby utterly disallow Revoke and disannul all and Every Other former Testaments wills Legacies Bequeuths and Executors By me in any wise before Named willed and Begeathed Hatifying and Confirming this and No Other to be my
