In the name of God Amen I Edward Southwell of South Carolina Orangebury District Planter Am Weak in Body but of sound perfect mind & Mery do hereby make my last Will & Testament-- First I resign my Sould to God who gave it hoping to enjoy the happy and blessed Fraistine of the Saints. Secondly I commit my Body to be buried at the discretion of my Executors. Thirdly I give & dispose of all my Worldly goods in manner & form following--

Item I give & bequeath to my well beloved Wife Sarah Southwell all my Household furniture to be for Use dursing her Lifetime after her Decease to equally divided between my three Sons and my Laughter Mary Southwell--Item I give & bequeath to my well beloved wife Sarah Southwell all my Stock of Cattle- dursing her natural Life, & after heer Decease to be equally divided between my three Sons Edward, John, William & my Daughter Mary Southwell & this I leave as my last Will & Testament, revoking & disallowing all former Wills & this I acknowledgeng & Set my Hand & Seal- affix my Seal in the Presence of these Witnefess & I leave my Wife & my Son Edward Southwell to be my Executors.
