

THOMAS ENUCKS

In the Name of God Amen, Know ye that I ~~the~~ Thomas Enucks being weak in body, but in sound mind and memory do make and ordain this my Last Will & Testament, first I Humble beseech the all mighty God to receive my Soul, Secondly I bequeath my Body to the dust from whence it was taken, and I request my burial to be done decent, at the discretion of my dear wife, & Executors, and all my worldly good I distribute in the following manner, first I give unto my dear & Lovin' Wife during her natural life or widowhood this plantation where on I now live, together with the working tools, household & kitchen furniture, horses & hogs, Except such a part as will be otherwise disposed of, also one Negro man named Gilbert, one Negro woman named Bridget, one Negro woman & Child Named Nanny & acabud Secondly I give unto my dear Son William one Negro boy named bob one negro Girl named dinah one Sorrel horse Saddle & bridle one feather bed & furniture also one tract of land containing 176 acres granted to me 6th day of June 1796, one tract containing 300 acres granted to Thomas Lebrie the 11th day of December 1796; one other tract containing 350 acres granted to me the 6th day of August 1797, I give unto my dear Son Isaac one tract of Land containing 200 acres by original Survey grant to me on the 4th day of September 1796 also Part of a tract of Land Containing 200 by original Survey which Said part of the tract lies adjoining Tarlton Browns & Youngs Land, the deviding Line to begin at Mathes Corner on a pine 3 x 6, and running abdixit Line across the Said tract untill it Strikes the back Line, also one tract of land containing 100 acres above Mrs Scott Now living also one Negro boy named Barwell County Wills 1797-1798
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named bob one negro Girl named dinah one Sorrel horse Saddle
& bridle one feather bed & furniture also one tract of Land
Containing 176 acres granted to me 6th day of June 1796, one
tract Containing 300 acres granted to Thomas Lebrie the 11th
day of December 1706; one other tract Containing 360 acres
granted to me the 6th day of August 1707, I give unto my dear
Son Isaac one tract of Land Containing 200 acres by original
Survey grant to me on the 4th day of September 1706 also
Part of a tract of Land Containg 200 by original Survey which
Said part of the tract lies adjoining Tarlton Browns & Youngs
Land, the deviding Line to begin at Mathes Corner on a pine
3 x 6, and runing abdirict Line across the Said tract untill
it strikes the back Line, also one tract of Land Containing
100 acres whear Mrs Gest Now Lives, also one Negro boy named
Adam, one negro Girl named Sendellire, Commonly called Fuge,
one horse Saddle & Bridle and Lot of Land in the village of
Barnwell, I give unto my dear Son Thomas one tract of Land
Contain,g 200 acres at the time of the original Survey grant
to Andrew Cunningham the 15th day of october 1704 one tract
of Land Containing 150 acres Grant to me on the 4th day of
September 1706 also one Lot of Land Lying in the village of
Barnwell, one Negro boy named Peter, one Negro girl named

vinus, Also all the land lyin Northwest of Cunninghams line
laid down in the $\frac{1}{4}$ lat N 30 W 55 also all the Cattle that is
known on Claine by my three Sons is to remain theirs without
any alteration, my neat Stock of Cattle debts due, (when col-
lected) Ready money & household & kitchen furniture is to be
Equally divided between my dear wife & three Sons, at the
will & derictions of my Executors hereafter to be named, &
further I do ordain & appoint My trustee friends my Lawful
Executors to put this my Last Will & testament in Execution
(that is to say) Tarlton Brown, Robert Bradly, Reehd Creech
& William Enucks, & I do further desire that the Property that
I have bequeathed away do Remain under the Care and deriction
of my Executors untill my Sons Comes to the age of twenty one
years, given under my hand this 13th day of october 1802
