In the Name of God Amen I William Adams of the State of South Carolina Barnwell District being weak & infirm in Body, but of sound mind and memory, for which I desire to be thankful to an Infinite & Bountiful Benefactor, do hereby make Constitute & ordain this my last Will & Testament Imprimus I recommend my body to the dust to be buried in a decent Christian like manner at the discretion of my Executors hereafter named & It is my desire that all my lawful debts be paid. It^m It is my desire that the plantation wher on I now live with all the utensils remain in the possession of my beloved wife Joanna Adams, together with three horses, and all my stock of Cattle Hogs Sheep during her natural Life, except two Colts the one a chesnut sorrel which I bequeath to my Son John Adams, the other a sorrel horse which I bequeath in like manner to my son William Adams to them & their legal heirs forever, I also bequeath two Cows & Calves to my Daughter Susanna Alfred ~~Alfred~~ to be delivered her at command, to her & her heirs forever Item I give & bequeath to my Son William Adams my Tract of Land containing one hundred & eighty seven acres adjoining the Tract wher on I now live to him & his heirs forever Item I will & bequeath three hundred Dollars to my Son James Adams to be put to Interest for his use until he arrives at lawful age to him & his heirs forever the said
