sorrel which I bequeath to my Son John Adams, the other a
sorrel horse which I bequeath in like manner to my son William
Adams to them & their legal heirs forever, I also bequeath two
Cows & Calves to my Daughter Susanna Alfred ~~XXXX~~ to be deliv-
ered her at command, to her & her heirs forever Item I give &
bequeath to my Son William Adams my Tract of Land containing
one hundred & eighty seven acres adjoining the Tract wher on I
now live to him & his heirs forever Item I will & bequeath
three hundred dollars to my Son James Adams to be put to Inter-
est for his use until he arrives at lawful age to him & his
heirs forever the said
