I William Boyit of the State of South Carolina Barnwell District through the abundant mercy of Gods goodneess though weak in body Yet of a Sound and perfect understanding and memory do Constitute this my Last will and testimony Testament and desire It may be Received by all as Such, I give up my soul to God and body to the just from whence in Came as for my burial I desire It may be decent with out pomp or at the discretion of my dear wife and my Executors hereafter named Who I doubt not will manage it with all Request and prudence as to my worldly Estate, I turn I give to winniford Dye and Jamina Boyit Josiah Boyit Bathany Tool and Ezekiel Boyit and Patience Red these my beloved Sons and Daughters here above named they are all Above Come Equal heir s in all my worldly propretty after my death Except my Negro fellow Adam and he is then to be free,<sup>d</sup> and I appoint my beloved Son Josiah Boyit and my Ezekiah Tool Executor to this my Last will and Testament. In will Witnefs whereof I have hereunto Set my hand and Seal this twenty fifth day of June In the year of our Lord 1808 and in 32nd<sup>th</sup> of American Indepence
