bounding N. W. ward part on Land laid out to Francis *Beard* and
Vacant Land N. E. ward on Land laid out to Nathan *Hinton* S. W. ward on Vacant Land

having such Shape, Form and Marks as are represented by a Plat hereunto annexed, together with all
Woods, Trees, Waters, Water-courses, Profits, Commodities, Appurtenances and Hereditaments whatsoever
thereunto belonging, To have and to hold the said Tract of *One Hundred* ———

Acres of Land, and all and singular other the Premises hereby granted unto the said
Jesse Deloche his ——— Heirs and Affigns, for ever, in free and cominon soccage.
