To all to whom these presents shall come, I David Horton

of Beaufort Dist in the State aforesaid, by my bond bearing even date with these presents, (on which bond Wm. Deloach & Dempsay stand as sureties) have acknowledged myself held and firmly bound unto Henry Goetts Sheriff of Beaufort District in the full and just sum of Twenty Seven Hundred and twenty two Dollars fifty Cents, conditioned for the payment of Unten Hundred and five by me twenty five

Now Know Ye, That I the said David Horton securing the payment of the said sum of Unten Hundred & sixty one Dollars & twenty five Cents unto the said Henry Goetts Sheriff his Successors assigns, together with lawful interest for the same, have bargained and sold, and by these presents, do bargain and sell, and in plain and open market, deliver unto the said

Henry Goetts his Successors, to wit the following Slaves to wit - Stephen, Admira & Emma

To have and to hold the said Slaves unto the issue of the females.

unto the said Henry Goetts his Successors, his Executors, administrators, and assigns, forever. Provided Always, Nevertheless, That if the said David Horton his Successors, his Executors, administrators, or assigns, shall and do well and truly

pay, or cause to be paid, unto the said Henry Goetts certain attorney, executors, administrators, or assigns, the full and just sum of Thirteen Hundred and sixty One Dollar and twenty five Cents according to the true intent and meaning of the said Bond aforesaid, and of these presents, together with lawful interest according to the stipulations thereof then this deed of bargain and sale, and all and every clause, article, and thing, therein contained, shall cease, determine, and be utterly void, and of none effect; any thing herein contained to the contrary thereof, in any wise, notwithstanding.

And it is hereby declared, by and between the said parties, and the said David Horton his Executors, administrators, and assigns, doth covenant, promise, and agree, to and with the said Henry Goetts his Successors, Executors, administrators, and assigns, by these presents, that if default shall happen to be made of, or in, payment of the said sum of Thirteen Hundred and sixty One Dollars and twenty five Cents as aforesaid, according to the true intent and meaning of the said Bond, that then, and in such case, it shall and may be lawful, to and for the said Henry Goetts his Executors, administrators, attorneys, or agents, from time to time, and at all times, hereafter, peaceably and quietly to enter into any, or all, the messuages, lands, or tenements, of the said David Horton and to take the said Slaves into his custody and possession, and the same to hold and detain to his own use and behoof, (as his own proper goods and chattels,) from henceforth and forever, or the same to sell and dispose of at will and pleasure; returning the overplus, if any should happen to be, after paying the said sum of Thirteen Hundred and sixty one Dollars and twenty five Cents unto the said David Horton his Executors, administrators, and assigns.
