ONE OTHER STONE—POSSIBLY GARRILLIA KIRK

This cemetery is located on the main highway leading to Hilton Head Beach. Hilton Head is an island off the coast of South Carolina and is part of Beaufort County, South Carolina. These inscriptions were copied by Mr and Mrs. Robert V. Burgess in November 1958. Mrs. Burgess is Regent of Bonaventure Chapter, National Society Daughters of the American Revolution.

Cement house--large enough for 20 caskets stands at the beginning of the cemetery. The doors are marble and one has been torn away. There are no caskets inside but this inscription on the house:

(This is a large stone inscribed on four sides)
and inside the iron fence.

Front side:

Be not satisfied
with these temporal advantages
He earnestly sought, By repentance
and faith in the Lord Jesus Christ
that "Inheritance, incorruptible, and
undivided, and that faideth not away,
Reserved in Heaven For all who obey
God" He was for many years previous
to his death a member of the Redeemer's
Church on Earth

Let not the wise man glory in his
wisdom, neither let not the mighty
man glory in his might, Let not the
Rich man glory in his riches
But let him that glorith glory in this,
that he understandeth and knoweth me,
That I am the Lord

Left side:

Sacred to the memory of

James Kirk
Born 9th Decr 1780
Died 9th Novr 1850

Back side:

Their children have caused this
monument to be erected to their
memory of their parents as an
evidence of their sense of the great debt
of gratitude they owe them

Right side:

Sacred to the memory

Mary E. Kirk
wife of
James Kirk
Born 9th Decr 1793
Died 30th Octy 1851
Just twelve months after the death of her
husband with whom she lived in
uninterrupted happiness for 43 years

The deceased was the daughter of
James and Martha Baldwin
