No 10 Amen, I, Aaron Clark of St. J^s. Goose Creek in the district and State aforesaid
do make this my last will and testament in manner and form following -
That is to say, I give and bequeath to my wife Susannah Clark one bedstead,
bed and bedding, one half the poultry, and ten dollars - Secondly I will and
desire that the remainder of my property of every description whatever be sold by
my executors herein after named, and after payment of the necessary expenses and
the ten dollars before mentioned - I desire that the proceeds be applied as follows
To wit to my youngest child one fourth part, to Aaron Gideon my next young-
-est, one fourth part, the remaining two fourth to be divided between my three chil-
-dren, Martha, Mary Ann, and Joseph in equal portions. And it is hereby
declared that the said Martha and Joseph is to have no farther claim whatever,

as the deed giving them the Cattle and the Mare was without consideration. And I have since settled with Martha for the Cattle - I therefore will and desire that should they or either of them claim any portions of my property other than under this will that in case, such one so claiming shall have no portion under this will but his or her portion shall be divided among my other children - I further will and desire that my Children Robert and Aaron be placed in the orphan house and that their portions be invested to the best advantage and paid to them on arriving at a suitable age. I desire further that my executors do act as guardian to my son Joseph and that he be put to some trade. Lastly I appoint Dr. H. G. Porcher and Isaac M. Dwight the survivor of them or such as may qualify, executor or executors of this my last will and testament - In Testimony whereof I have hereunto set my hand and seal this 26 day of July 1841 - Aaron Clarke (S.D.)
