on before the first day of June now next ensuing.

I John Dunder of Charleston in the Province of South Carolina being not very well  
in health and being, having my mind understanding and  
knowing the nature of my death to come and confirm this  
my last Will and Testament, I do first committing my  
body to the earth to be interred until the day of Judgment  
when I hope for a glorious Resurrection thereof and  
my soul into God that I give it to be by him translated  
unto the company of the Spirit of just men made perfect  
after my death being paid among body decently buried  
I do and bequeath unto my two sons Aaron and  
Thomas my

Which is two fifty acre

Lot with the house that is on it and two Quarter  
of land lots in the place that was designed for a place of  
Trade and two Lots that were between brother William  
& me I give them my part of them and my part of a  
two acre Lot that was between brother William & me  
and I give them my part of a Lot that was between  
brother William & me & a lot adjoining to brother Miller  
And I give Thomas two acre Lot lying between  
Cowan Dunes and Bush Creek and one Lot of four  
acre and three Quarter lying in the street called the  
Mill Lane & my part of the said Land that is yet  
undivided all to be equally divided between my son  
Aaron and my son Thomas I give to my Grandson  
John May the son of my son John May a Lot in the  
second division of Lot containing forty five acre of Mann  
shatony to be delivered to him when he is twenty years  
old and if he be dead yet without being then I give to be  
to my sons Aaron and Thomas for their heirs be  
equally divided between them

 in the year of our Lord One thousand seven hun-  
 dred and thirty.

Letters Patent to Aaron Way granted to him  
Way and Thomas Way

That whereas these presents shall come passing  
the 11th day of June 1731 the thirty first day of January  
which was in the year of our Lord One thousand seven  
hundred and thirty One the said Aaron Way and Thomas  
Way of this Province of South Carolina were present  
and approved and allowed of the said deed having whith  
he lived and at the time of his death owed & goodly  
and credits within that province of South Carolina  
whereof the approbation and allowing of this Deed  
and the power of granting the division of all and singular  
the goods rights and credits of the said deceased  
man of worthy Memory to be long and that the division of  
all and singular the goods rights and credits of the said  
deceased and his testamentary manner of way concerning  
was granted and committed unto Aaron Way & Thomas  
Way named Executors in the said last Will and Testament  
being last deceased on the holy Evangelist with a  
respectfully to administer and make a full and perfect  
Inventory of all and singular the goods rights and credits  
of the said deceased to such like his name in the public  
Office in Charleston in order to be recorded not before  
the first day of June next ensuing and provided
