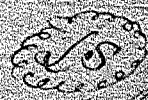

her heirs and assigns forever on condition that she never marries again
but in case she should marry again, then I give and devise to her her
heirs and assigns one third part of my said Estate real and personal
and the other two thirds to my five sons their heirs and assigns share
and share alike I constitute my Wife sole Executrix of this my
last Will and Testament hereby giving her whole single full
power to sell any and every part of my Estate and to vest the
proceeds in such other property or stock as she pleases to think
of this Will. My Children being young I prefer that they should

be dependent on their Mother on whose prudence and discretion I have the most implicit reliance she can provide for their wants as they occur better than I can anticipate them. Witness my hand this thirtieth day of December in the Year of our Lord One thousand eight hundred and thirty Six. A Blanding
