I, Adolph Brinkman of the District of Columbia Saint James Green Creek Parish being of sound and disposing mind and memory, but weak in body and calling to mind the uncertainty of life, and being desirous to dispose of all such worldly estate as it hath pleased God to bless me with, do make and ordain this my last Will in manner following, that is to say: After payment of my just debts and funeral expenses, I give to my daughter Mary Brinkman five dollars. All the residue of my Estate both real and personal consisting of the following property viz my present residence known as the eighteen mile house, and all the buildings thereto belonging and seventy acres of land thereto attached, one negro fellow named Baby together with my stock of horses, cattle, and hogs, Household and Kitchen furniture, stock in trade &c, I give to my beloved wife Jane, H. B. Brinkman and the heirs of her body forever. And lastly I do constitute and appoint my said wife sole Executrix of this my last Will and Testament by me heretofore made. In testimony whereof, I have hereunto set my hand and affixed my seal this twenty fifth day of January in the year of our Lord one thousand eight hundred and thirty four.
