Baron of Charleston, Physician, being of sound & disposing mind & memory, but mindful of the uncertainty of life do make publish & declare this to be my last Will & testament, hereby cancelling & revoking all former or other wills & testaments by me heretofore made - I give devise and bequeath all my estate real & personal of every kind & nature whatsoever, in possession, remainder & expectancy unto my beloved Wife Sarah G. Baron her heirs, executors, administrators & assigns forever, and constitute & appoint her my sole Executrix - Witness my hand & Seal this 24 November 1840, ——— Alex^r. L. Baron (S.P.)

Box 13 The State of South Carolina In the name of God Amen. No. 5. I, Ann Hillman of the City of Charleston in the State aforesaid Widow, being in good health and of sound memory and understanding, and being desirous of settling my worldly affairs whilst I have strength and capacity to do so, do make and declare this my Last Will and Testament in manner following, that is to say: ———
