ty of human life do make, publish and declare this to be
my last will and Testament revoking and making void
all others. In the first place, it is my will and desire that
all my just debts and funeral expences be first paid, and
in the next place I give eight shares in the Union Bank of
this City now standing in my name to my two half sisters Jane
or Jennie Batey and Elizabeth Kirkpatrick share & share alike
In the next place I wish my Executors or Executor to sell my lot
of land in St Philip's Street within a twelve month after my decease
for the best price that can be obtained and should the lot
realize more than the sum I paid for it which sum I wish
to be equally divided amongst my three half brothers Thomas
Alexander and Robert Kirkpatrick and my half sister's son
Andrew Batey and the surplus over the said amount paid
by me, if any should be I give to my said half sister's son Andrew
Batey. And in the next place I give my beds and bedding equally
between my two half sisters Jane or Jennie Batey and Eliza-
beth Kirkpatrick and my wearing apparel I give between
my three (3) half brothers. I wish my body to be carried to
Winnisborough in Fairfield District and there to be interred
by my father's side.

by my Father's grave: And should I not leave sufficient
money over and above my above bequests to defray all necessary
expenses incident on my funeral and other expenses I request
that a sufficient portion of my Bank Stock above named be sold
by my Exor or Exors for that purpose And lastly I nominate
constitute and appoint my friends John McKee and David
M Sandreth Executors of this my last will and Testament
In witness whereof I have hereunto set my hand and
seal this tenth day of September Anno Domini Eighteen
hundred and forty five the words "and my half sister's
son Andrew Batey", being first interlined between the
nineteenth and twentieth lines from the top of the first
page of this my last will
