I give to my said sister M^{rs} Mary Rivers, my Gay Chain with the covers belonging thereto. To my Grand niece M^{rs} Sarah Eliza Doyley, I give and bequeath my Diamond Ring: not to be liable for her husband's debts, and if necessary, I constitute my Executor, trustee to secure this bequest. I give to James Sanders Guignard the Sanders boat of Arms and my seal in conformity to a promise I made him. To my nephew J^r William Miles Rivers I give my Silver pencil case of curious workmanship. I give and bequeath to the Charleston Protestant Episcopal Domestic Female Missionary Society, my Silver Stand, In Trust for St Stephens Chapel, Guignard Street; and I direct to be engraved thereon at the charge of my Estate, the following words "Presented to St Stephens Chapel to be used in administering the Lords Supper to the sick." I give and bequeath unto my niece M^{rs} Sarah Baker my double set of drawers and my Gold watch and appendages. To my said niece Ann Sanders Fabian I give and bequeath all my Plate, Plated ware, Silver and Jewels not otherwise herein before disposed of specifically: also my bedstead in my bed chamber with my suit of curtains and Toilette, two changes of linen, the basin stand in my room, the double set of drawers now used by my said niece, my Bible and other books, my new Feather bed, bolster and Pillows which I now make use of, and my

new Seamen bed, bolster and Pillows which I now make use of, and my
mattress. My little negro girl Hager I give and bequeath unto my friend
John W. Mitchell his heirs, Executors administrators and assigns forever, also
I give to him my small set of Drawers in the passage. All the rest of my Es-
tate real and personal I give devise and bequeath unto the said John W. Mitch-
ell my Executor hereinafter mentioned, his heirs Executors administrators and
assigns, In trust to sell and dispose of the same at public or private sale in
fee simple or otherwise and for cash or on credit as he may think fit, and
proceeds thereof, of all my just debts and funeral expences and also retaining
to himself thereout, whatever he may be entitled to under this my Will
as Executor or otherwise, Then for this in trust to divide the residue of said
proceeds between my said Sister Mrs ~~John~~ Mary Rivers and my said niece
Ann Sanders Fabian share and share alike, her and their heirs Executors
and Administrators. It is also my Will and I do hereby direct that my said
Executor shall retain to himself five per cent on what he may receive and the
like per centage on what he may pay away in credit, debts, legacies or otherwise
during his Executorship together with all such charges and commissions as are
usually allowed by law to an Executor. Lastly I nominate constitute
