The State of South Carolina. In the Name of God Amen. I Anne L. Bahussee of the Parish of St Georges Dorchester, now temporarily residing in the City of Charleston, in the State aforesaid, being weak in body, but of sound and disposing mind memory and understanding, do make and declare this to be my last Will and Testament, in manner and form following, That is to say, after payment of all my just debts, and all just charges against my estate, I Give and Bequeath ~~and~~ all my Estate, real and personal of every description whatsoever, unto my Sister Martha and Henrietta, during their joint lives, and to the survivor of them absolutely, her heirs, executors Administrators and assigns forever after the death of the other - except a Bond of William & Gustavus Cain to me, conditioned for the sum of four hundred and Eighty Dollars, which bond with whatever of principal and interest may be due thereon, at the time of my death, I Give & bequeath to my Brother Daniel Bahussee. And I do hereby nominate & appoint my said Sister Martha ~~and Henrietta~~ Executrices of this my last Will and Testament, I hereby revoking all and every other Will and wills heretofore by me made.

In witness whereof, I the said Anne L. Bahussee, have hereunto set my hand and seal this twenty first day of July in the year of our Lord One thousand eight hundred & thirty six.
