First. I recommend my Soul to God who gave it, and my Body I bequeath to the Earth, to be decently Interred as my Executors shall direct.

Item First. I direct that all my debts and Funeral Expences be fully paid and satisfied.

Item Second. Whereas by a certain Deed of Trust, John King Junior holds certain property in Trust for me, and to and for my sole and separate use, benefit and advantage of myself and my heirs. It is therefore my Will that the same be disposed of in manner following, that is to say I give and Bequeath unto my loving Husband Bartholomew black, during his natural life, all the Right Title (and Interest which I now have (in and by virtue of a certain Deed of release to John King Junior in trust for me the said Ann black which said Deed bears date the eighteenth day of October One thousand Eight hundred and thirty seven) to all the claim which my son Bartholomew black Junior, before the execution of the said release had in to or out of All that lot of Land in King Street known & designated by the numbers One hundred & sixty one (N^o 161) and One hundred and sixty three (N^o 163) which I purchased from him the day of the date last aforesaid, to and for the use of my said Husband during his life and at his decease, then to revert to my said Son Bartholomew black Junior his heirs Executors and Administrators.

Item Sixth. It is my Will that my Ten Negroes named Sue, Peter, Moses, Baby, and infant Sarah, Selma, Grace, and Ned, Betty & Sophia with their future issue and increase, which said Slaves are ^{now} held in trust for me, by John King Junior, be sold and the proceeds, paid to my said Husband Bartholomew Blake with which proceeds together with the proceeds of the Bank Stock aforesaid, It is my Will that he recommence self, That he do enjoy the proceeds of sales of the said negroes and Bank Stock aforesaid during his life, and at his death, That the same

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Sixty one (61) Shares in the Joint Stock of the Georgetown Bank otherwise called Bank of George Town, and that my said Husband shall during his life, have, hold and enjoy the proceeds of the same (not subject however to any of his debts or liabilities) and at his death the same to revert and be equally divided among my children which I leave living share & share alike.

Item Fourth. I Give and bequeath to my Daughter Jane Kelly and my Two Grand Daughters Virginia and Elizabeth Kelly (now in Mobile) my Mulatto Girl named Cynthia, with her future increase and issue to them and their heirs forever.

Item Fifth. I Give and Bequeath unto my Daughter Maria Silcox and her children for ever my Negro woman Martha, with her future issue and increase.

Item Sixth. It is my Will that my Ten Negroes named Sue, Peter, Moses, Betsy, and infant Sarah, Decca, Grace, and Ned, Betty & Sophia with their future issue and increase, which said Slaves are ^{now} held in trust for me, by John King Junior, be sold and the proceeds, paid to my said Husband Bartholomew Clarke with which proceeds together with the proceeds of the Bank Stock aforesaid, It is my Will that he commence self. That he do enjoy the proceeds of sales of the said Negroes and Bank Stock aforesaid during his life, and at his death, That the same or so much thereof as may be left shall be divided among my children share & share alike.

Item Seventh. It is my Will and desire that my faithful old Negro woman Judy shall not be sold, but I leave her to the care and protection of my Husband to be used and dealt with according to his discretion, I do give and bequeath to my said Husband during his life my Negro woman Fanny now loaned to W. H. Kelly in Mobile and also my Negro woman Lydia now in the possession of Isaac Waterfield, And I do hereby Nominate, constitute, ^{make order} and appoint my said loving Husband Thomas Columbus Black and my Esteemed Friend John King Junior Executors of this my last Will and Testament.
