and remainder of my whole Estate Real and Personal (including the Bond
I am now in possession of Mr. Henry Cobia) I give, devise, and bequeath
by to be divided among my following named Relations, viz., Miss Eliza & Eliza
Miss Anna Elfe, Miss Eliza Coote, Mr. Hamel Ann Groom, Miss Louisa Groom
and Mr. John Carter Junr. Their heirs Executors, Administrators and assigns
in case either of my said relatives, should die before me, but provided
or children living at my decease, it is my will that such child

should represent his, her, or their parent or parents, and take the entire or Shares of
the Said Rest and Remainder of my Estate, to which this parent or parents would
have been entitled if living. — Lastly, I nominate Constitute and appoint
Doctor Henry C. Brown, and Mr. Avery Cobia, to be Executors of this my Will. —
