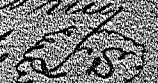

my House and Plantations on James Island on which I reside during
the Winter containing about eighty or ninety acres together with the Stock
household and other furniture thereon with the exception of such parts
thereof as are herein otherwise disposed of And also the following
Negroes, Bido, Betsy, James, Abraham, Doll, Quash, Clarissa
George, Quincy, Joby, Patty, Grace, Charles, Chloe, Daniel, and Peggy
during her Natural life and after her death to her children share and
share alike To Edward Mallory Purch son of Edward Christopher
Purch Adverse my House and Lot in Savage Street with the following
reservations that is to say reserving to Mrs Burns during her life the
occupation of the Garret Room she is now in and also reserving the
South Eastern most extremity or portion of the said lot which said
portion extends to the West as far as the Garden fence to the North
as far as a line drawn ^{said garden fence to the} from the Corner of the ^{Corner of the}

bed Mattress bolsters two pillows and old curtains belonging to the
same my Mahogany Bureau desk and the dressing Glass attached
to it round Tea Table and water and wash hand Stand on James
Island Also my old Mutch Hagar with her daughter Dorinda
and Grand daughter Sylvia To my ^{Daughter} Cousin Muckin fuss my
Island adjoining Mr Grandearis and Two town Cut containing

about one hundred and forty acres subject to the payment within one year after
my death of the following legacies amounting in all Seventeen hundred dollars
To Maria Susan and Ann Daughters of the late Reverend Dr. Furman one
hundred dollars to be equally divided among them. To the Reverend Dr. Aaron
Seland one hundred dollars and the like sum to the Rev^d A. Burt. To
the Orphan House one hundred dollars. To my Nephew Robert M Rivers
to Miss Ann Ball and to the Children of the Rev^d Mr. Floyd Three hundred
dollars the hundred dollars for Mr. Floyd's Children to be equally divided
among them. To Mrs Martha McKay fifty dollars (\$50) To my Nephews George
Rivers and Benjamin Stiles Rivers Two hundred dollars each To Benjamin
Stiles Rivers and Edward C Burch in trust for my Niece Loue Royall the
Wife of Crokeys Royall Three hundred dollars. To Louisa and Mary
Children of my Wench Nancy one hundred dollars a piece to be employed
by my Executors for their education. To Augustus son of my Wench Mary
Horry fifty dollars to be applied in like manner. To Benjamin Stiles
Rivers and Edward C Burch I give in trust for my said Niece Loue
Royall my Negroes Amanda Kate Jimmy and Shad. To Edward C
Burch I leave the piece of land on James Island adjoining Mr. Matthews
tract containing ten or eleven acres lately occupied by my Nephew Robert
Mallory Rivers Together with old Sary her son Harry and Melly I in trust
to permit the said Robert M Rivers to use and enjoy the same during his
life and after his death to and for the use benefit and behoof of the
Children of the said Robert M Rivers. To Robert Bee son of my half
Sister Mrs Heriah Bee I leave my Negroes Fortimer, Fortune, and favor

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in trust for his said Mother and Subject to her disposal by Will or deed
To my Cousin Naomi Anderson I give my Negro Wench Mary and her issue
To Thomas and Edward Mellichamp sons of my deceased Cousin Eliza
Mellichamp my two Negroes Peter and William. To my friends and Executors
Edward O Burch Josiah Taylor and Robert R Taylor and the survivor
of them her Executors and Administrators I leave my Wench Nancy and her
Children Susan and Mary and her future issue by reason of her faithful
Services and my Wench Mary a Muttatto and her Child Augustus and
any other Children she may have with this special Charge that no other
Service or wages shall be required of them than may be sufficient to
pay their Taxes. I leave to Margaret Ann Burch my Negro Girl Eliza
To Mrs Martha Godber my Wench Phoebe and to Edward O Burch
my Negro Sarah and the Clock kept at my house on James Island. To
Mrs Martha Rivers Wife of Benjamin Hiles Rivers and to Mrs Semina
Oswald I leave fifty dollars each. And lastly I nominate and appoint
Edward O Burch Josiah Taylor and Robert R Taylor Executors of this
Will who after paying my just debts and the two legacies last provided are
earnestly requested to fulfil the same in every other respect. Witness my

I leave to Marguerit Ann Burch my Negro Girl Eliza To Mrs Martha Godber my White Phoebe and to Edward C Burch my Negro Sarah and the Clock kept at my house on James Island. To Mrs Martha Rivers Wife of Benjamin Stiles Rivers and to Mrs Semina Oswald I leave fifty dollars each. And lastly I nominate and appoint Edward C Burch Josiah Taylor and Robert R Taylor Executors of this Will who after paying my just debts and the two legacies last provided are earnestly requested to fulfil the same in every other respect. 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and bequeath to my said Executors another portion of my said lot measuring
in depth from Savage Street Twenty five feet and in Width thirty feet and
bounded on the West by Savage Street and on the South by Lands of the
Estate of William Rivers. I give Nancy Twenty Dollars for a mourning suit
I also give my Negro Gal Cook to my Executors with the same trust as specified
concerning Nancy (her Mother) and her Sisters Louisa and Mary. I also give
to the said Cook the sum of One hundred dollars payable (as the legacies
to her mother and sisters) by Edward O Burch. I give Lucy, Dido Annsey,
and Mary Henry Five dollars each. In Witness whereof I have hereunto
