No. 5 - The State of South Carolina In the name of God Amen  
I, Ann Hillman of the City of Charleston in the State aforesaid Widow being in good health and of sound memory and understanding, and being desirous of settling my worldly affairs whilst I have strength and capacity to do so, do make and declare this my Last Will and Testament in manner following that is to say: - First and principally, I commend my soul to the hands of Almighty God, hoping for the pardon and remission of my sins through the merits of the Saviour, my body I commit to the earth to be decently interred, at the discretion and under the direction of my Executors hereunto

In the next place I desire all my just and lawful debts and funeral expenses to be punctually paid and discharged. Item I give and bequeath to my niece Mrs. Ann Beck, wife of Charles Beck of Columbia, the following negro slaves viz. old Phoebe, young Phoebe, and Prince a Carpenter, together with the issue and increase of the said two female slaves that may belong to me at the time of my death, also the whole of my silver plate, with the exception of the Coffee pot hereinafter mentioned, the whole of my wearing apparel and my gold watch and jewels and trinkets of every description, with the exception of my diamond ring, and gold watch hook hereinafter mentioned. I also give and bequeath to the said Mrs. Ann Beck one half of the whole bed and table linen I may be possessed of at the time of my death, and also my yellow chintz bed curtains. Item I give and bequeath to Mrs. Sophia Ewart wife of David Ewart of Columbia, my diamond ring, and gold watch hook which I beg her to accept and wear for my sake. Item I give and bequeath to Mrs. Harriet Potter wife of the Reverend William Potter, as a token of my kind remembrance of her, my silver coffee pot, without any name or marks on it. Item Having sometime ago given Robert Anderson of Charleston a female negro slave named Sue, I hereby declare that although no formal deed was executed by me, yet I intended the said negro slave, and any future issue and increase she might have, to be a gift to the said Robert Anderson, and therefore hereby confirm the gift and direct my Executors herein after named to do whatever may be requisite to carry my intention into effect, in case any thing further be necessary. Item I give devise and bequeath all the rest residue and remainder of my estate and effects real and personal, whatsoever <sup>wherever</sup> to Thomas Napier who was the husband of my late beloved daughter Eliza. But in case of the death of the said Thomas Napier in my life time then I give devise and bequeath the same to the next of kin of the said Thomas Napier.

But in case of the death of the said Thomas Napier in my life time, then I give devise and bequeath all the said rest, residue and remainder of my Estate and effects real and personal, to his daughter Ann T Napier, for her sole and separate use, and not to be subject to the debts, contracts or engagements of any husband whom she may marry, and with power to her by any deed in her lifetime, or by any writing in the nature of her last will and Testament to dispose of all or any part of the property hereby given devised and bequeathed to her, also without the consent of any husband whom she may marry. Lastly I hereby nominate constitute and appoint the said Thomas Napier and Mitchell King, to be the Executors of this my last Will and Testament. And I do hereby revoke and declare void, all former wills by me at any time made, declaring this to be and contain my Last Will and Testament. In witness whereof I have hereunto set my hand and seal this third day of September in the year of Our Lord one thousand eight hundred and thirty six. Ann Hillman *E.T.*
