Item, It has pleased Heaven in my old age to bereave me of my Dear son William Price, to whom, I have long looked as the main earthly comfort of my declining years and as the just and exclusive Heir of all real or personal of which I might die possessed at the time of my death. and his dear Widow and his children by her, now stands to me in his place and from their continued, duty, Kindness and affection to me, are well entitled to all I intended for him, I do therefore give devise and bequeath all my Estate real and personal, whatsoever subject to the payment of my debts and funeral expences as aforesaid - unto my Dear Daughter Eliza Price, the widow of my said son, to and for her own sole and separate use and benefit, for and during her natural life, with full power and authority in and by any deed under her hand and Seal in her life time or in and by her last will and testament to give and dispose thereof or of any part or parts thereof and for such estate or estates as my said Daughter may think proper to such child or children of my said Daughter by my said son or his, her or their Issue as my said Daughter may think fit, and in default of such gift or disposition thereof by my said Daughter, and as to so much thereof as may be left so undisposed of at her death - then I give devise and bequeath the same and every part thereof - to the

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authority in and by any deed under her hand and seal in her life time or  
in and by her last will and testament to give and dispose thereof or of any part  
or parts thereof and for such estate or estates as my said Daughter may think proper  
to such child or children of my said Daughter by my said Son or his, her or their  
Issue as my said Daughter may think fit, and in default of such gift or dis-  
position thereof by my said Daughter, and as to so much thereof as may be left  
so undisposed of at her death - then I give devise and bequeath the same  
and every part thereof after the death of my said Daughter unto my grand chil-  
dren, the children of the said William Price, their heirs and assigns forever.  
The Issue of any deceased child or children of my said Son at the death of my  
said Daughter, taking among them that part or proportion, to which the parent  
or parents if alive would have been entitled, and in default of such disposition  
by my said Daughter, and as to so much thereof as may be left so undisposed of -  
at the time of her death - and also in default of the said child or children  
of my said Son or his, her or their Issue living at the time of my said Daugh-  
ter's death, then I give devise and bequeath the same and every part there-  
of unto the right Heirs of my said Daughter, their Heirs and assigns forever.  
Finally, I constitute, nominate and appoint my said Daughter Eliza Price  
the sole Execution of this my last Will and Testament, with full power and  
authority to sell and dispose of any part of my Estate, seal and personal  
as she may think proper and I hereby revoke and annul all former and  
other Wills by me at any time heretofore made and I ratify and confirm  
this and my attempts to my last Will and Testament
