Just and lawful debts. Item I give to my daughter Selina R. Green my two servants
Amelia and Colin with the increase of the former. Item, My other servants Tenah
Ned, Sam. and Isaac, with the increase of Tenah, I wish sold and the amount
received for them to be equally divided between my daughter Ann B. Devereaux
and Grand daughter Ann L. Snowden share and share alike. Item In conse-
quence of the faithfulness of my servant Breeta, I feel disposed to give her, her free-
dom, but as the laws of the State forbid it, I leave and bequeath her to my Daugh-
ter Selina R. Green with my earnest request that she will not exact any wages
or money from her but protect her during her life time, this latter request I
intend to oblige my children. Item, It is not my wish, that any of my servants
should be forced to go into the country to live. Item, What furniture I may die
possessed of I leave to my son Joshua L. Snowden. I do hereby nominate appoint
and constitute my sons William E. Snowden and Joshua L. Snowden my

Executor with full power, to carry this my last Will and Testament into full effect, dated at Charleston 25th October 1833

Parish called Boltons adjoining the above, purchased by me from William Brisbane
Also a Tract of Land adjoining Boltons Tract purchased by me of
Also seventy acres purchased by me from John Miller, reserving therefrom, One
Hundred and Five feet square, on the road leading from the Sea Shore to
the public Road, for a Burial place for me and my Descendants forever,
with the free liberty of ingress, egress and regress at all times, into and from the
same. I also give and bequeath to my said son Samuel Venning, all my feet
Carts, Horses, mules and plantation tools, and also my Negro Woman Pat and
her five children, together with the issue of the females to be born after the date
of this my Will, and likewise one Bed, Bedstead, Mattress and Furniture
and my Secretary and Clock. Item I give to my said son Samuel Venning and
to my Nephew Robert M. Venning and our nephew
