Edward depart this life before me, leaving a child or children
then and in that case, such child or children shall take the
share, the Parent would have been entitled to if alive.

Item I Give and Bequeath one third share or third part to my
son John Harleston, his Heirs Exors. admors. and assigns forever, But
should my said son John depart this life before me leaving a child
or children, then such child or children shall take the share, the
Parent would have been entitled unto if alive.

Item I Give and devise the remaining share or third part to
my sons John and Edward Harleston and the survivor, his Exors. admors.
and assigns forever. In trust for the use of my Daughter Hannah
Harleston Quaker for and during her natural life, and at the
death of my said Daughter, then in trust for such child or chil-
dren of my said Daughter Hannah Harleston Quaker as may be living
at the time of her death, share and share alike. But should my
child of my said Daughter depart this life before their Mother
the said Hannah Harleston Quaker.

Then and in that case, such child or children shall take the share, the Parent would have been entitled to if alive.

Item I Give and Bequeath the one other share or third part to my son John Charleston, his Heirs Exors Admors and assigns forever, But should my said son John depart this life before our having a child or children, Then such child or children shall take the share, the Parent would have been entitled unto if alive.

Item I Give and devise the remaining share or third part to my sons John and Edward Charleston and the survivor, his Executors Admors and assigns forever. In trust for the use of my Daughter Hannah Charleston Quack for and during her natural life, and at the death of my said Daughter, then in trust for such child or children of my said Daughter Hannah Charleston Quack as may be living at the time of her death, share and share alike. But should any child of my said Daughter depart this life before their Mother the said Hannah Charleston Quack, but leaving a child or children, such child or children, shall take the share to which their parent would have been entitled unto, if he or she had survived my said Daughter. Lastly, I leave my sons John and Edward Charleston ^{to be my} Executors to this my last Will and Testament.
