 ation of the sum of Forty pounds curr. money to me in hand paid
 by my son in law Charles Harris, of Charles Town in the said Province of
 these presents assigned and set over unto the said Charles Harris, all my
 right Title interest claim and Demand whatsoever that I have to the
 Negroes men the one named Charles and the other John, heretofore Mortgage
 by me to Mr. Alexander Mabel, as may appear by Deed of Mortgage bearing
 date the twenty ninth Day of May 1728 and Potestaty for myself my
 heirs Executors and Admors fully to replace the said Charles Harris his Executors
 Admors and Assigns in full for all our wages or Gains that the said
 Negroes have since that time earned and also is agreed to Com. round
 with the said Alexander Mabel his Attorney in Equity and Admors agreeable to
 the terms mentioned in the said mortgage and to receive in his Custody
 the said two Negroes to have and to hold the said two Negroes unto the
 said Charles Harris his heirs Executors Admors and Assigns to him or their
 use and behoof for ever in witness whereof I have hereunto set my
 hand and Seal this twentieth Day of April Anno Domini 1731
