happening shall be born & sustained by me then
William Spodee my Ex^{ts} or Adm^{rs} & the said
Spodee my Ex^{ts} & Adm^{rs} the said Negro Slave
herein before Bargained & sold unto the said
Isaac Holmes his heirs Ex^{ts} Adm^{rs} & assigns
against all & every person or persons who so
shall & will warrant & for ever defend by
