I have the honor to acknowledge the receipt of your letter of the 11th inst. in relation to the case of the James W. Smith and to inform you that the same has been forwarded to the proper authorities for their consideration.

I know all men by these presents that John Toole Merchant
of Northay County in the Province of Maryland am held by
firmly bound unto John Claiborne of the same place in
the full Just Sum of three hundred pound Sterling money
of Great Britain to be paid to the said John Claiborne his
Certain Attorney heirs Executors or Assigns to which I
paymont well & ready to be made I bind myself my heirs
Exors & assigns firmly by these presents signed with my Seal
dated the thirty first day of January Anno domini 1736.

The Condition of this obligation is Suche that if the above
bounden Archibald Hamilton shall well & truly pay or Cause to
be paid to the said John Maclellan (or to any other Person or Persons
under the hand & Seal of Bridget now wife to the said Archibald
Hamilton lately widow to Patrick Roche of the County & Province
aforesaid appointed to receive the same) the Sum of one hundred
fiftie Pounds like Sterling Money in the Currency of the Province
is bestowed to Matthew Roche Joseph Roche John Roche & Anne
Roche Children of the said Patrick Roche & the said Bridget now
living in Ireland or to any one or more of the said Children or to
any other person or persons according to the direction at the date
of the said Bridget's will also permit the said Bridget to make &
execute a Letter of attorney under her hand & Seal to the said John
Maclellan or to any other Person or Persons at any time when
he shall think fit to receive & use for said Sum of one hundred &
fiftie Pounds Sterling & to dispose of the same according to her
direction to any one or more of the said Children or to any other person
or persons as he shall think fit & also if the said Archibald Hamilton
shall permit the said Bridget by her last will & testament to dispose
of the said Sum of one hundred & fiftie Pounds (provided she
doth not dispose of the same during her life unto her said Children
or to any one or more of them or to any other person or persons as she
shall think proper without any lett hindrance or molestation
whatsoever a living other person or persons without authority given
& save the said Bridget doth not dispose of the said one hundred &
fiftie Pounds during her life nor by her last Will & testament
if then the said Archibald Hamilton shall well & truly pay
or Cause to be paid the said Sum of one hundred and fiftie
Pounds to the said John Maclellan for the joint use of the

Matthew Joseph Jordan of the Parish of St. Peter & St. Paul
his Parish Priest hereby testifies that when he said Mass
Rocha shall come to the age of fifteen years without fur-
ther delay then the obligation to be void of none
effects otherwise shall remain in full force & virtue

the sons & are the lawful husbands & liegemen of His Majesty
King George his acts & deed in use & the force for the use
therein mentioned & that they both adhered to the same
as Witnesses.

presentes sealed with my seal & oed this my first
day of January Year 1763

Whereas David K. Robt. of Berkeley Cal.
is the owner of the above described land, and
Negroes & other persons of slight appearance and the
children Matthew K. Robt. North Anna Jordan

Proctor John Roche which now are in the possession of the above bounden Archibald Hamilton by his late marriage with Bridget widow of the said Patrick Roche now the condition of this obligation is such that if the above bounden Archibald Hamilton his heirs & admors shall not at any times or by any way or means whatsoever charge or require of or from the said Matthew Joseph Jordan or Anne Roche for their maintenance in Diet Clothing or Schooling any more than what the use of the said Negroes & other Chattels shall amount to till the said Children & every of them shall come to age; whereas the said Matthew Joseph Jordan & Anne Roche are now in Ireland if the said Archibald Hamilton shall at any time when the said Bridget shall require the same lend or pay or cause to be paid the Charges of transporting the said Children from Ireland to this Province at his own proper Cost & Charges than this obligation to be void & of no effect otherwise to be in full force & virtue

Letter of administration to John Machintosh granted to Andrew Allen & Charles Hill

By his Excellency Robert Johnson Esq. Gov. Genl. of the Province of the Carolinas & Ordinary of the same

To Andrew Allen & Charles Hill of Charles Town Marsh

Whereas John Machintosh of Winyaw Plantation lately deceased having whilst he lived and at the time of his death diverse goods rights and credits within the Province of the Carolinas by means whereof the full disposition & power of granting the admision of all & singular the goods rights & credits of the said John Machintosh decd & also auditing the accounts Calculations & reckonings of the said admision & a final Dismissal of the same to me is manifestly known to belong Demanding the goods rights & credits of the said decd may be well & truly administered converted & disposed of To here by grant unto the said Andrew Allen & Charles Hill (in whose stead in this behalfe I very much confide) full power by the tenour of these presents to administer the goods rights & credits of the said decd which to him in his life time & at the time of his death did belong and to ask & receive of all persons & receive the Claims & to pay the debts in which the said decd stood & to go so far forth as the said goods rights & credits will extend according to their rate & order of law being first sworn on the holy Evangelists of almighty God to make a true & perfect inventory thereof to be kept at the same as the Secretarys office in Charles Town in order to be recorded on or before the first day of December nexte now next ensuing And to render And to render a just & true account Calculation & reckoning of the said admision when thereunto required And to ordaine Depute a Constitute you the said Andrew Allen & Charles Hill admors of all & singular the goods rights & credits of the said decd, in the execution

I shall see to authorize & Impower you or any three or four of you whose names are hereunder written to the said page shall visit parts & places within this Province as you shall be directed by Andrew Allen & Charles Hill of Charles Town Marsh Administrators of the goods & credits of John Machintosh late of Winyaw Plantation and wherever any of the goods of the said decd are or do remain within the said parts & places which shall be shown to you by the said Andrew Allen Charles Hill or either of them & there you shall appraise all goods, the said goods being first sworn on the holy Evangelists of almighty God to make a full & perfect inventory & appraise ment of the same the same to be taken in your hands or any three or four of you into the Secretarys office in Charles Town in order to be recorded on or before the first day of December nexte now next ensuing
