the time of his death diverse goods rights and Credits

jurisdiction and power of granting the admision of all
singular the goods rights and Credits of the said
decd and also the auditing the acct^s Calculations &
reckonings of the said admision and a final dismission of

the same to me is manifestly known to belong Dying
that the goods rights and Credits of the said decd and also
may betwell and truly administered Conceded and Dispensed
of So hereby grant unto the said William Bellinger the
whose fidelity I very much confide full power by the
tenour of these presents to administer the goods rights
and Credits of the said decd which to him in his life time
and at the time of his death did belong and to ask collect
