Buck Parish do hereby Revoke and disannul all other wills by me heretofore made
and do hereby declare this to be my last Will and Testament, first, I give to my son
Thomas Harvey three negroes viz. Jesse, Sib and Catty during his natural
life time and after his death the said three negroes with the increase of the
females to be equally divided among his surviving children. Secondly, I give to
my daughter Sarah Cantley one negro girl named Rachel during her natural
life time and after ~~her~~ her death the said negro Rachel with her increase is
to go to my grand Daughter Elenor Harvey, Daughter of the said Sarah Cantley
but if the said Elenor should die leaving no Issue then the above mentioned
negro Rachel with her increase, is to go to my surviving grand children,
the negro Rachel bequeathed to the said Sarah Cantley and also two of the
negroes which I give to my son Thomas Harvey viz. Sib and Catty is to be
valued and appraised and the difference paid to the said Sarah Cant-
ley in money by my Executors, thirdly, I give to my Daughter Elizabeth
Throver two negroes viz. Hester and Mary during her natural life
time after her death the said two negroes with their increase is to go
to her children but should she die leaving no Issue then the said two
negroes with their increase is to return to my surviving grand children.
Fourthly, I give to my grand Daughter Sitney Wood Harvey one negro
girl named Breash, but if my grand Daughter S. W. Harvey should leave
no Issue then the said negro Breash with her increase is to go to the survi-
-ving Brothers and Sisters of the said S. W. Harvey, fifthly, I give to my grand
children viz. children of my son John Harvey

...ing Brothers and Sisters of the said J.W. Harvey; fifthly, I give to my grand-
children viz children of my son John Harvey deceased a sum of money
equal in value to the two negroes above mentioned left to my son Thomas
Harvey viz Lib and Caty, the sum of money to be put at Interest until the
youngest Child of the said John Harvey deceased arrives at the age of twen-
-ty one years, then the said sum of money to be equally divided among them
share and share alike. Sixthly, I give to my Grand children viz children
of my son James Harvey deceased the same amount of money that the
above mentioned John Harveys children is to have the money also to be
put at Interest until the youngest Child of the said James Harvey de-
ceased arrives at the age of twenty one years, then the money to be equal-
-ly divided between them share and share alike. Lastly, I give and be-
-queath the Balance of my personal property to be equally divided share and share
-alike between my three children and grand-children, viz Thomas Harvey
one equal part, ~~and~~ Sarah Cantley one equal part, Elizabeth Thrown one equal
part, and my grand children viz children of my son John Harvey deceased
one equal part to be divided equally among them, also my grand children
viz children of my son James Harvey deceased one equal part to be divided
among them, and no part of the property which I give and bequeath to my
before mentioned Children is to be moved ~~carried~~ or taken out of the State
without the approbation and consent of my Executors and do hereby nomi-
-nate and appoint my son Thomas Harvey and my son in law Elisha
Thrown Executors to this my last will and Testament in witness whereof
