or Assigns to which I saym: will & truly to be made I bind my
self my Heirs Executors & Assigns firmly by these Presents sealed with
my Seal dated the seventh day of August in the year of our Lord one
thousand seven hundred & twenty four

The Condition of this Obligation is such that if the above bound Benj
Delafield Consulting his Heirs Executors or Assigns shall & do well & truly pay or
cause to be paid unto the above named W^m Martin his Ex^r Attorney
at Law the Sum of Twelve hundred Pounds of Good & Lawfull money of England
with the Lawfull interest thereon from the day of the date hereof until the day of
the payment thereof & if he shall fail to do so then the whole Sum of Twelve hundred
Pounds with the Lawfull interest thereon shall be due to the said W^m Martin his Ex^r Attorney
at Law & he his Heirs Executors or Assigns shall be bound to satisfy the same
without any defence or excuse whatsoever
