

Deed of Gift from Martha Parsons to her Daughter Mary

To all to whom these Presents shall Come I Martha Parsons of Charles Town in South Carolina in the Province of South Carolina Widow and Governing Mother do hereby certify that I have and bear unto my Daughter Margaret Parsons with Love and granted unto her by this present Deed of Gift and Grant unto my said Daughter Margaret the full Right and power of Land containing Fifty Seven Acres and a half situated lying and being on Ashley River in the Province aforesaid adjoining to and of Capt Edmund Bollinger, one half of the said Land containing the same of Elizabeth Clay, and one half of the said Thomas Rivers, with all and every the appurtenances belonging or appertaining to the said Land in the said Province (in Case the said Land should happen to be Disposed of) and also one Quarter Part with all and every the Furniture thereunto belonging and two good Rings and two Silver Spoon vizt One for Spoon and one large Spoon Marries on the said Land so as that M. P. has Eighty pounds in Cash and also all my wearing apparel To Have and to Hold all and singular the above said and things unto the said Margaret Parsons her Heirs Executors and Assigns (from and Indefinitely after my decease) for ever To the only proper and absolute Use and behoof of the said Margaret Parsons her Heirs Executors and Assigns for evermore In Witness whereof I have hereunto set my Hand and Seal this Eighth Day of November Anno Domini 1729 And in the third Year of his Majesty King George the Third
