be payable or shall become payable on my shares in the Planters and Me-
chanics Bank of South Carolina And I do further authorise and improve
my said Executor herein after named to sell and transfer all my said
Shares in the said Planters and Mechanics Bank of South Carolina without
any application whatever to any Court whatever; And, I, give and bequeath
to my beloved Sister Sally (a slave belonging to Mr D C Levy of the said
City of Charleston) the nett proceeds arising from the sale of two shares in
the said Planters and Mechanics Bank of South Carolina; Also, I give
and bequeath to my beloved niece Betsey, daughter of my said Sister
Sally (a slave belonging to Mr. S O Levy of the said City of Charleston) the
nett proceeds arising from the sale of four shares in the said Planters and
Mechanics Bank; Also all my bedding, furniture and apparel of every
kind whatever, All the rest residue & remainder of my money and estate
whatsoever not before given & disposed of, after payment of my just debts
and funeral expences, I give and bequeath unto my said Executor herein after
named his Executors, Administrators and assigns And I do nominate and
appoint my esteemed young Master Doctor Micah Jenkins Raper Executor
of this my last Will and Testament, In witness whereof I have here-
unto set my hand & seal at Charleston this twenty seventh day of November in
the year of our Lord 1800

my said Executor herein after named to sell and transfer all my said
Shares in the said Planters and Mechanics Bank of South Carolina without
any application whatever to any Court whatever; And, I, give and bequeath
to my beloved Sister Sally (a slave belonging to Mr. D C Levy of the said

the said Planters and Mechanics Bank of South Carolina; Also, I give
and bequeath to my beloved niece Betsey; daughter of my said Sister
Sally (a slave belonging to Mr. D C Levy of the said City of Charleston) the
nett proceeds arising from the sale of four shares in the said Planters and
Mechanics Bank; Also all my bedding, furniture and apparel of every
kind whatever; All the rest residue & remainder of my money and estate
whatsoever not before given & disposed of, after payment of my just debts
and funeral expences, I give and bequeath unto my said Executor herein after
named his Executors, Administrators and assigns And I do nominate and
appoint my esteemed young Master Doctor Micah Jenkins Roper Executor
of this my last Will and Testament. In witness whereof I have here-
unto set my hand & seal at Charleston this twenty seventh day of November in
the year of our Lord One thousand eight hundred & thirty five and in the fiftieth
year of American Independence -

Box 9 The State of South Carolina I, John Falls Walker of Charleston
No. 17 in the State aforesaid do make and declare my last will and Testament
in manner following. In the first place I direct my Executors and Executors to
collect what is due to me and to pay my debts. Item until my eldest son
George attains the age of Twenty four^{years}, I direct that my Estate real and personal
be kept together for the education of my children and the maintenance of my
family, including therein my Mother-in-Law, Mrs. Jane Flint, who, I desire should
after that period, still have a home with my wife and children. Item, I give
all my Estate real and personal to be equally divided between my wife and
children, share and share alike. Item, when my eldest son George William
attains the age of twenty four years I direct that a division be made of my
Estate, either by the appraisement of disinterested persons, to be appointed by my
Executors and Executors, or by a sale, as to them shall appear most advisable.
Item,
I give the share which may then be allotted to my eldest son, to him, his heirs
and assigns in severalty. Item I give the share which may be allotted to my
wife, to her, her heirs and assigns, to be for her sole and separate use, and not
subject to the Control, Contracts or debts of any future Husband. And to be also
in satisfaction of all claims on my Estate. Item, I give the shares which
may be allotted to my sons Joseph Flint and William Aiken and to any
other child or children, that may hereafter be born, to them, his and their
