State aforesaid, in trust nevertheless to be given by her to and for the sole use
benefit and behoof of, Patty, the woman slave of the said Mrs Ann Kingman
on whom I solemnly enjoin the faithful and religious execution of the said
trust. And hereby revoking all other wills and testaments by me made
I hereby nominate, constitute and appoint John Michel Esq^r of the city
and State aforesaid sole Executor of this my last will and testament.

thirty five and in the fifty ninth year of American Independence
