First I give & bequeath the whole of my property in England, left me by my late Father to my nephew Charles Edward Lawton, son of my Brother Ralph. Secondly I give & bequeath to my relations and others as follows, all my real & personal property in this country say the U. S. of America or elsewhere not already bequeathed viz: To my Brother Ralph and his children two sixths part thereof. To my Brother Joseph one sixth part thereof. To my Brother Ralph in trust for my Brother Samuel and his children one sixth part thereof. To the children of my Brother James deceased one sixth part thereof. To the children of my Sister Mary deceased one sixth part thereof. And one sixth part thereof being the last as follows viz: To the City Council of the City of Augustine East Florida One thousand Dollars for the Education of the Poor of that City. This sum to be invested by my Executors in some safe stock & the Interest to be paid annually to the City Council as aforesaid. To the St Augustine Episcopal Church Five hundred Dollars. To my godson Charles Lawton Beaz one thousand Dollars. To the episcopal & Methodist ^{Sunday} Schools of my native village Salford in England Five hundred Dollars each. To my Cousins the remainder of this one sixth in equal proportions. And I do constitute and appoint my Brothers Ralph & Joseph to be my true & lawful Executors to carry this my last will & Testament into effect. Signed

or elsewhere not already bequeathed viz: To my Brother Ralph and his Children two Sixths part thereof. To my Brother Joseph one Sixth part thereof. To my Brother Ralph in trust for my Brother Samuel and his Children one sixth part thereof. To the Children of my Brother James deceased one sixth part thereof. To the Children of my Sister Mary deceased one sixth part thereof. And one sixth part thereof being the last as follows viz: To the City Council of the City of Augustine East Florida One Thousand Dollars for the Education of the Poor of that City. This sum to be invested by my Executors in some safe Stock & the Interest to be paid annually to the City Council as aforesaid. To the St Augustine Episcopal Church Five hundred Dollars. To my Godson Charles Lawton Beaz one thousand Dollars. To the episcopal & Methodist ^{Sunday} Schools of my native village Selph in England Five hundred Dollars each. To my Cousins the remainder of this one sixth in equal proportions. And I do hereby constitute and appoint my Brothers Ralph & Joseph to be my true & lawful Executors to carry this my last will & Testament into effect.
